LEAGUE STRUCTURE POLICY

The following is an Appendix to the REGISTRATION POLICY to clarify the procedures and to determine the team composition for each division.

- The following table will be used to determine the number of players required per division based on the number of teams and the numbers of players on the field of play for each division. These numbers are based on a minimum of 3 substitutes per team.

- If the minimum number required (within 2 or 3 of the minimum number) to have 6 teams for a specific division by the first exhibition week the number of teams will be reduced to 4 teams for that division.
- The following table will be the assigned times for each division based on the registration numbers.

- These times will also be based on the number of registration by the first week of exhibition play.
- The scheduled dates for League play will be based on a minimum of 19 weeks and a maximum of 22 weeks.
- The League schedule will be structured to ensure that all games are completed (including play-offs) the week (Saturday) prior to the elementary school March Break.
- Any changes to this Policy must be approved by the Executive.
